



## ALLOWED

- Making flyers/ posters broadcasting your campaign slogan
- Talking to your fellow classmates about why would make a great officer
- Asking your homeroom teacher if you're able to share with the class that you're running for office
- Campaigning with a fellow classmate (for example: two student want to run for President/Vice President with each other and make posters together/ campaign as a team)
- Requesting to speak on the announcements (to Mrs. Tolson or Ms. Mitchell) to introduce yourself to the student body

## NOT ALLOWED

- Making any banner or sign larger than a standard poster board
- Damaging or vandalizing any other candidates' flyers/posters
- Talking negatively or gossiping about any fellow candidates
- Bringing treats or incentives to students in exchange for their vote
- Campaigning on social media
- Promising incentives that you cannot guarantee to students in exchange for their vote

\*\*It is your responsibility as a leader to follow these rules and to communicate any rules being broken to Mrs. Tolson or Ms. Mitchell. If a candidate is not able to uphold the rules listed above, they are subject to be disqualified from running.\*\*
